

Golan and Gamla

BIBLICAL STUDY OF GAMLA (“Camel Mountain”) AND BETHSAIDA. GAMLA IS QUITE POSSIBLY ANCIENT NAZARETH WHERE YESHUA GREW UP

TIME

- ✓ All-day, approximately 8:00 am – 5:00 pm with a 45-minute break for lunch at Gamla. Meet at the place of your Israel accommodations.



TRANSPORTATION

- ✓ Your rental car or van

COSTS

- ✓ Guide: Avinoam
 - \$350.00 USD. Tips: optional. Fee payable with Israeli Shekels, US Dollars, Euros, British Pounds, MasterCard, Visa, Discover, Carte Blanche, or American Express. If you wish, split up the total costs among all participants
- ✓ Lunch
 - Recommended: bring a backpack with picnic lunch items – sandwiches, fruit, snacks, water to drink.
- ✓ Entrance costs
 - National Parks card or about 35 Shekels per person for Gamla
 - About 60 Shekel per vehicle for Bethsaida

DETAILS

- ✓ Bring with you:
 - Bible, hat or umbrella, backpack, camera, recording device (if you wish), sunglasses (if you are accustomed to wearing them), energy snacks (if you wish), bottled water (generally 1.5 to 2 liters per person), good walking or hiking shoes/boots, shorts (if you wish).
- ✓ What to expect:
 - Hiking and walking through archaeological ruins on dirt and rock paths.
 - **Hike to the mountain called Gamla is optional on this program.** If hiking Gamla, expect 2 to 3 hours of moderate hiking (total round trip) and another 1 to 1.5 hours of on-location studies at the synagogue and at the “brow of the hill.” Gamla is quite possibly the ancient city of Nazareth, where Yeshua grew up.
 - Hike includes a one hour (round-trip) hike to the “brow of the hill” on which the city is built – Luke 4:29.
 - Easy to moderate hiking and walking on dirt, rock, and stone paths.
- ✓ Young children accepted (above the age of 6 or 7)
 - Not suited for infants, prams, or people with long walking - hiking challenges.
