TIME

COSTS

- ✓ Lunch
 - Choice of Caesarea area restaurants. Approximate cost about 60 Shekels per person. No need to purchase lunch for Avi.
- ✓ Entrance costs
 - National Parks card or about 35 Shekels per person for Caesarea
 - National Parks card or about 35 Shekel per person for Fort Antipatris

DETAILS

- ✓ Bring with you:
 - Bible (book or digital), hat or umbrella, backpack, camera, recording device (if you wish), sunglasses (if you are accustomed to wearing them), energy snacks (if you wish), bottled water (generally 1.5 to 2 liters per person), good walking or hiking shoes/boots, shorts (if you wish).

 - Hiking and walking around archaeological ruins on established paths.
 - Generally, easy walking on dirt and stone paths.
