BIBLICAL STUDY OF ANCIENT JERUSALEM. STUDYING TOPOGRAPHY, VALLEYS, AND BORDERS FROM THE EAST, SOUTH, AND WEST, INCLUDING THE ANCIENT CITY OF DAVID

TIME

- ✓ All-day, approximately 8:00 am – 5:00 pm with a 1 hour lunch. Meet at the place of your Israel accommodations.

TRANSPORTATION

- ✓ Your rental car or van

COSTS

- ✓ Guide: Avinoam
 - \$350.00 USD. Tips: optional. Fee payable with Israeli Shekels, US Dollars, Euros, British Pounds, MasterCard, Visa, Discover, Carte Blanche, or American Express. If you wish, split up the total costs among all participants ***If Avi has to meet the group in Jerusalem, approximately \$100.00 extra for time & travel costs will be added, unless Avi is already in the city. Overnight accommodations for Avi added to total group expense.***
- ✓ Lunch
 - Approximately 45 Shekel per person at any one of a number of eateries
 - No need to purchase lunch for Avi
- ✓ Entrance costs
 - City of David: approximately 50 Shekel per person (includes 15-minute film)

DETAILS

- ✓ Bring with you:
 - Bible (book or digital), hat or umbrella, backpack, camera, recording device (if you wish), sunglasses (if you are accustomed to wearing them), energy snacks (if you wish), bottled water (generally 1.5 to 2 liters per person), good walking shoes/boots, shorts (if you wish). Hezekiah's Tunnel: bring battery-powered headlamp or handheld light, water shoes, or shoes to get wet.
- ✓ What to expect:
 - City of David: hike underground and in the water of the Gihon - Hezekiah's Tunnel (2 Chronicles 32:1-5, vv. 31-32). Underground walk in calf-deep water for about 40 minutes. Tunnel is relatively narrow and low in places. Very tall or large people need to let Avi know and a determination will be made.
 - Generally, easy to medium difficulty with walking on stone paths.
 - Walking through the City of David is generally easy but it has some challenges for folks who are not in reasonably good physical health.
